Constitution

The constitution drafted by John Myerscough was duly adopted as a good and comprehensive document for the formal running of the cycling club. The constitution will provide a structure for the cycling club to function in an orderly and efficient manner and allow for actions to be undertaken in an open and transparent manner. The constitution whilst laying down a framework for the running of the club also encourages members to be involved in its operation and management.

Election of post holders

John Myerscough was elected as Secretary.

Roddy Pattison was elected as President / chairperson.

No volunteers were forthcoming for the role of treasurer. John M agreed to act as temporary treasurer until membership grew and a permanent treasurer could be co opted.

Subscriptions

Subscription fee for joining the club was agreed as £10.

Subscription forms had been prepared in advance and 4 were completed on the night.

Club Account

It was agreed that a KCC bank account be open with RBS Kinross. All payments from club funds will require the signatures of both Roddy P and John M. **Action JM**

Scottish Cycling

It was agreed that KCC should affiliate with Scottish Cycling.

This would give all KCC members 3rd party insurance when participating in any club run.

The 6 present agreed to pay £20 each so that the £120 affiliation fee to Scottish Cycling could be paid. As new members join a rebate of £10 would be given to each of the 6 founder members in turn.

Club Jerseys

Club cycling jerseys were briefly discussed but it was agreed to leave this until KCC had 20 or more members wanting to buy a club shirt before we needed to proceed with design and supplier.

It was agreed that KCC colours would be purple and yellow.

Club Runs

The time of the Sunday during the summer months was debated with some preferring an 8:30 am start. It was however agreed to continue with the Sunday meet as 9:00am from the High School but to review this at a future date.

From April onwards we would introduce a Thursday night club run rendezvousing at the Kinross Leisure Centre at 6:45pm

Etape Caledonia

It was decided not to enter a team of 5 from KCC as teams are to be given a later starting time they individuals. This could compromise chances of individual riders not achieving sought after times as they would be encumbered by slower riders as they progress through the field.

Newsletter

Roddy Pattison agreed to put details of the formation of the club into the next Kinross newsletter.

It was agreed in principle that the club would organise its own time trial for KCC members only.

The obvious course was for around Loch Leven. Roddy to investigate if a suitable loop or deviation can be added so the distance can be made up to 15miles.
