<p>2. Finance Update - £37,415 balance in the bank, approx. £18,700 is from the Sportive. The online banking is working well. We are still running 2 accounts and it was suggested that a new treasurer can deal with this along with other changes needed. The majority of payment are going out of the new account. It was noted that Ann is standing down. A vote of thanks was passed by the committee for all Ann's hard work.</p>	
<p>3. Sportive – The planning is on track with places slowly being taken up. The are 637 places sold. Press release will go out from CHAS to publicise the Sportive. Graham noted that there is a website call Sportive.com where events are advertised and suggested that we may wish to promote our event on here. He thinks its free. More volunteers are needed. Volunteers are being signed up using Entry Central. We have confirmed that the feed-stop in Dunning will be at the school. Donnie (Synergy) has confirmed that this is his last year of sponsorship.</p>
