1. Minutes of last meeting	The minutes were approved, with the correction of the spelling of George Shanley second name	
2. AGM minutes	Noted that these can be published as a draft minute with the following amendments. Neil Curr did not second his nomination as Treasurer FCA coordinator is to be Richard/Mhairi Laffoley	To be published as a draft on the website once the changes have been made
3. Committee roles and updates	Membership Secretary – Linda. It was noted that there had been some issues with BC. It was agreed to set a deadline date of 10 th April and put another reminder out. If members have not joined by this point they will be removed from the Spond Group, and the closed Facebook group as well as the WhatsApp groups. Bike Box management – this has been Richard but he is looking to hand this over. George is willing to take this on. This involves dealing with booking, dealing with the deposit required etc. Noted that the bike boxes are kept at the KCC container. GP series – this required organisation of 10 events run over a Thursday evening. George will take this on. Web site/IT – Richard will cover this along with Trevor covering the Sportive. Andy has also offered to help and this was accepted. There was a discussion regarding updating this, and Andy will assist with this. Kit manager – George is happy to continue with this. It was noted that there is still some old kit, but mostly in small or larger sizes. This will be available to purchase at the Sportive. Awards ‘night’ – Jane asked for some volunteers to assist with this. Linda and Jenny offered.	Membership reminder to go out on Spond (Jane). Richard will attend to the Facebook group. 4. CWPO	Jane completed the Adult Wellbeing and Protection Office training (WPO). It was noted that the club needs to recruit another CWPO . Jenny is going to complete this training on Monday 6 th April.	
5. GP series & FCA events	Jane has looked at the calendar for this, and the dates will largely be replicated for 2026. Noted that there are some FCA events that Kinross run, 2-3 events in total. Mhairi is reviewing the risk	Jane/ Richard to recruit volunteers

assessment for some of the courses and will update members as to what events she will be seeking club support for.

It was suggested that we look to the TT groups for volunteers first, then seek volunteers via Spond.

6. First Aid Course It was noted that KCC would not likely have enough people to warrant a first aid course, but the plan is to link with Mhairi Laffoley to explore whether we can run something jointly.
7. Membership renewal issues Linda reported that there were a number of issues with people being able to renew membership, and these seem to have been more pronounced over the last 2 weeks. Jane has sent an email to BC and will notify us when she receives a reply. Website/IT team will explore other possible options to bring back to the committee
- Discussed alternatives to renewing via BC. Suggestions included DD/SO or via our website. However, it was agreed that there are advantages in having the payments collected via a third party.
